WHAT IS GAIN™?

GAIN™ stands for Golf: Accessible and Inclusive Networks. GAIN™ is also a research project examining the potential of the game of golf as a medium to maximize opportunities for inclusion for people with disabilities into the social fabric of their local communities.
